Privacy Notice - Data Protection Act 1998

Dronfield Junior School are the Data Controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act. We collect information from you, and may receive information about you from your previous school. We hold this personal data and use it to:

- support your teaching and learning
- monitor and report on your progress
- provide appropriate pastoral care; and
- assess how well our school is doing

This information includes your contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information, where you go after you leave us and personal characteristics such as your ethnic group, any special educational needs you may have as well as relevant medical information.

We will not give information about you to anyone without your consent unless the law and our policies allow us to.

We are required, by law, to pass certain information about our pupils to our local authority (LA) and the Department for Education (DfE).
